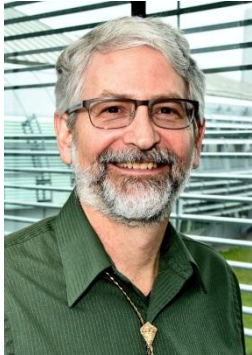

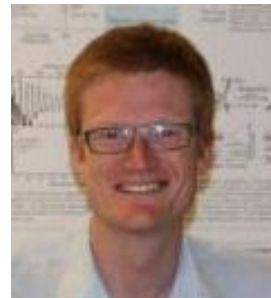

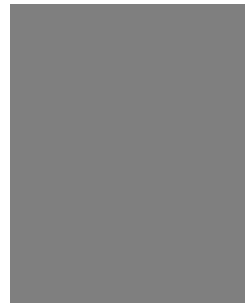

Finalized Charter

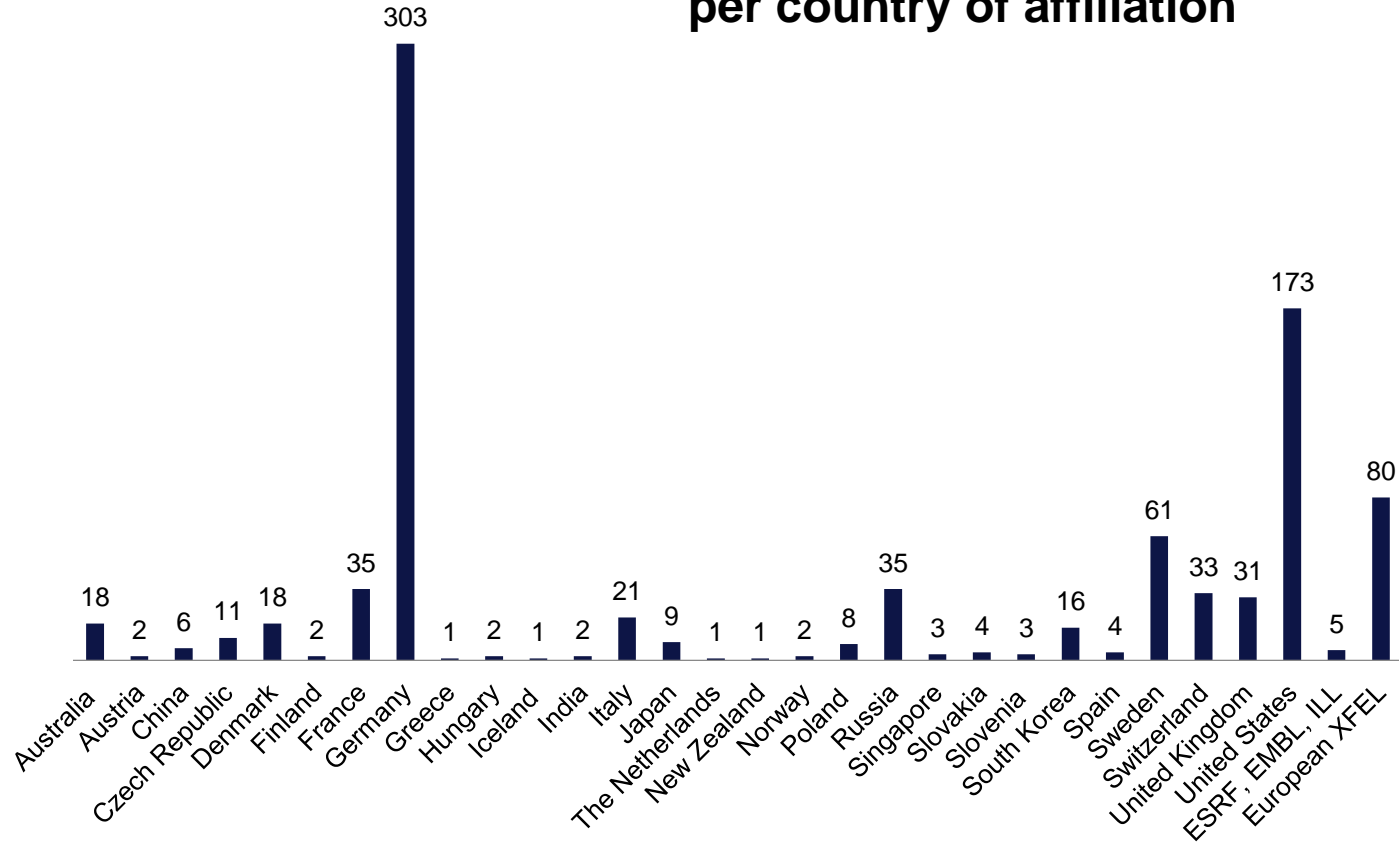
